Dear Beth Courtney:

This letter shall serve as notice to KLTL-TV of DIRECTV's intent to provide local into local service in the Lake Charles, LA designated market area ("DMA") in accordance with Section 338 of the Communications Act of 1934 and the Federal Communications Commission's Rules.

The local receive facility in the Lake Charles, LA DMA is located at: 129 West Prien Lake Road, Lake Charles, LA 70601.

We are required to inform you that (1) you have the right to elect mandatory carriage or retransmission consent with respect to the remainder of the three-year "election cycle" ending on December 31, 2011; (2) you have thirty days from the date you receive this notice to make such election; and (3) failure to make such election will result in your loss of the right to demand mandatory carriage for the remainder of this three-year cycle.

We note, however, that Louisiana Public Broadcasting has already entered into a Retransmission Consent Agreement (the "Agreement") with DIRECTV. Please be advised that carriage of KLTL-TV will be governed by the terms of the Agreement.




